S pring is just around the corner. It all begins on Wednesday, March 20th at 4:58 CDT. I love Spring! I love it more than most because I grew up where winter was more like winter. Every night I saw the temperature drop well below freezing and every day I saw the winds howl every afternoon. In high school, baseball started in January and ran through May which meant about half of the season was played in the winter. I enjoyed everything about baseball except shivering in the outfield. I remember going to bed one night looking forward to a ballgame the next day. When I awoke the next morning there was 27 inches of snow in my backyard. our dining area festive and fun.




